East Palestine Train Derailment Information.

On February 3, 2023, a Norfolk Southern train transporting vinyl chloride derailed in East Palestine, Ohio, which is located approximately 190 air miles Northeast of Lucasville. In an effort to avoid an explosion, a controlled release and burn of the vinyl chloride was performed on February 6th.

Northwest Regional Water District is a Consecutive system of Scioto County Regional Water District 1 (Water1). In short all of our water is supplied by Water1. The raw water comes from wells near the Scioto River Bottoms. All wells are supplied from the Teays River aquifer.

Northwest Regional Water District is confident there will be no impact on our water quality resulting from the East Palestine spill. Northwest Regional Water District meets or exceeds all water quality testing requirements set by Ohio EPA and will continue to test to ensure the safety of our customers.
